RULES OF SIKKIM TRIBAL RESIDENTIAL AND ASHRAM
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS SOCIETY

SHORT TITLE & COMMENCEMENT :

1. The name of the Society shall be "Sikkim Tribal Welfare Residential & Ashram Educational Institutions Society".
2. The Registered Office of the Society shall be situated at Gangtok.
3. They shall come into force with effect from the date of registration.

DEFINITIONS :

4. In these Rules unless the context otherwise requires :-
 - (a) "BOARD" means the Board of Governors constituted under Rule 8 of the Rules of the Society.
 - (b) "CHAIRMAN" means the Chairman of the Board of Governors.
 - (c) "SECRETARY" means the Secretary of the Sikkim Tribal Welfare Residential and Ashram Educational Institutions Society.
 - (d) "RULES" means the Rules of the Sikkim Tribal Welfare Residential and Ashram Educational Institutions Society (Regd.), 1998.
 - (e) "AUDITOR" means Auditor appointed under Rule 10.
 - (f) "MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE" means the Standing Committee (Adm. & Finance) and Standing Committee (Academic) under rule 8.
 - (g) "GOVERNMENT" means Government of India and Government of Sikkim.

AIMS & OBJECTS OF SOCIETY :

5. The aims and objects of the Society is as follows:-
 - a) To establish, promote, maintain, assist, finance, support and/or aid or help in setting up of Residential School

- b) To open, establish, promote, set up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and/or aid or help in setting up and/or maintaining and/or running hostels, libraries, reading rooms, swimming pools, play grounds, games courts, gymnasium and other training and vocational institutions.
 - c) To manage finances, decide location of school, select students, formulate policies and programmes for management, improvement, diversification and any other related matter with regard to the functioning of these schools.
 - d) To accept donations, contributions, grants from individuals, institutions, industrial and business houses and Governments including foreign donors.
 - e) To raise moneys and funds for the benefit of Society, to invest the funds with such individual, societies, firms or companies, Banks etc for providing income on such terms and conditions as may deem proper and necessary for the fulfillment of the aims and objects of the Society and to further its interest as enumerated above.
 - f) To execute contract and suits, institute or defend suits or other legal proceedings.
 - g) To do all such other lawful acts, deeds and things as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the aims and objects or any of them.

6. The Society is purely a non-political, social welfare oriented Society with the aforesaid aims and objects.

7. a) Without prejudice to the generality of the above objects and for effectively carrying out the same the Society shall have power to acquire, receive, hold and possess any property including securities of any kind and to construct and maintain any buildings to manage transfer or otherwise dispose of property both movable or immovable or deal in any property or security and to enter into any contract for or in connection with the purposes of the society.

b) The Society shall have the power to frame rules and bye-laws.

8. The management and control of the Sikkim Tribal Welfare Residential Ashram Educational Institutions Society shall be in the hands of Board of Governors and Management

Committees of the Society and shall be in accordance with bye-laws as may be framed or modified from time to time.

9. The Society shall consist of the following members:-

- a) Chairman
- b) Secretary to Government, Welfare Department - Member
- c) Secretary to Government, Education Department - "
- d) Secretary to Government, Personnel A.R. & Trg. - "
- e) Finance Secretary or his nominee not below the rank of Additional Secretary - "
- f) Principal, TNA - "
- g) Eminent Educationists - 2 Members
- h) District Collector, North - "
- i) Adakshya, North District - "
- j) Chairman, Tribal Welfare Board - "
- k) Principal of the School - "
- l) Community leaders - 4 Members

The members specified in clause (g), & (l) of sub-section (9) shall be elected in accordance with such procedure as may be prescribed and hold office for a period of 3 years.

- 1) The Society may at any time remove any member if it is proved that such member is guilty of misusing his office for private profit or he is incapable of discharging his duties as a member due to mental or physical infirmity.
- 2) The Society may remove from office any member other than an ex-officio member who is absent without leave of the Society from more than three consecutive meetings thereof without cause sufficient, in the opinion of the Society, to exonerate his absence:

Provided that no member shall be removed from office under sub-section (1) or (2) unless a reasonable opportunity has been given to him to show cause against such removal.

- 3) Any member (other than one who holds office in ex-officio capacity) may resign from office by giving notice in writing to the Chairman, and such resignation being accepted by the Chairman, he shall be deemed to have vacated his office with effect from the date of his resignation or such other later date as may be specified.

10. The Society shall, in its Annual Meeting, appoint an Auditor (which term includes a firm of auditors) who is qualified to audit Company Accounts, to audit the accounts of the school for the year in which the Annual Meeting is held :

Provided that the same Auditor shall not be appointed for more than three consecutive years.
